English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)

If English is not your first language and you want an opportunity to improve your reading, writing and speaking and listening skills then join one of our ESOL classes!

We have courses to suit everyone who wishes to learn or improve their English.

Our courses will prepare you to progress into employment, further study and give you more independence in everyday life. We can help you find the right course that suits your levels and needs. A qualified tutor will check your current skills levels and offer you a course straight away or put you on our waiting list for your level and availability. If you need to wait for a course, you will be contacted as soon as a place becomes available. Courses are subject to availability and eligibility.

How do I apply?

Eligibility criteria needs to be met so please enquire and check if you have the right residency to apply. Make an initial application through our website.

A tutor will contact you and invite you for an assessment and discuss your needs. Although our courses are free, there may be a charge for exams fees. You will be required to show evidence of your residency during your assessment, which will be carried out face to face at one of our centres. ESOL courses are in high demand therefore places are limited.

Marlene's story; English and Maths Open Doors to Nursing

My name is Marlene and I received a brochure about Warwickshire Adult & Community Learning programmes and was interested in enrolling in an English course. I was assessed and was accepted onto a Functional Skills English Level 2 class. After gaining an English qualification in 2020, I enrolled on Functional Skills Maths Level 2 and gained my qualification in 2021.

To apply for my university course I needed Functional Skills English and Maths qualifications, and I am truly fortunate that I was able to provide precisely what was needed. It was a wonderful experience being back in a class and socialising with different people. Multiply is a new government-funded programme to help adults improve their numeracy skills.

If you're aged 19 and over and don't have a maths GCSE at grade C (or equivalent), you can access free numeracy courses through Multiply to build your confidence with numbers and gain a qualification. Good numeracy skills may unlock job opportunities and lead to higher wages or prepare you for further study. They also help in everyday life, such as helping children with homework and budgeting money. We offer a range of courses using Multiply funding such as Family Learning classes, Dressmaking and Craft courses. There are courses for beginners that can lead to more

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Enrolment Fees & Eligibility

Fees

English, Maths, Family Learning and other classes, including Essential Digital Skills, are free. You will be required to complete an eligibility form for all English, Maths, IT and ESOL courses that are free.

Details of the fees for each course can be found on our website. Please contact us for further advice. For ESOL and some ICT courses, you may be eligible for a free course and exams if you are employed but earn less than £20,319 per year.

Where fees apply, we operate the following categories:

- A Full fee (depending on eligibility and/or non Warwickshire resident)
- **B** Discounted fee (50% for learners aged 66 or over)
- **C** Fully remitted (FREE for learners in receipt of qualifying benefits)

Am I eligible?

We accept learners aged 19 or over on 31/08/2023. Most learners are required to have been permanently resident in the UK for the last 3 years. If you do not meet these criteria please contact us. We are not funded to work with learners living in the West Midlands Combined Authority area. If you pay your council tax to Coventry, Birmingham, Solihull, Walsall, Sandwell, Dudley or Wolverhampton please contact us for more information as different fee rates may apply.
