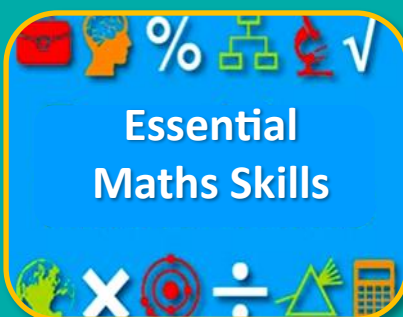
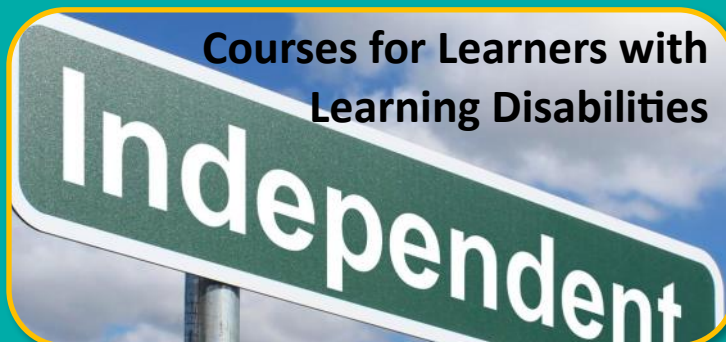

Fees & Eligibility Information

English, Maths, Family Learning and other classes, including Essential Digital Skills, are free. You will be required to complete an eligibility form for all English, Maths, IT and ESOL courses that are free.

Details of the fees for each course can be found on our website. Please contact us for further advice. For ESOL and some ICT courses, you may be eligible for a free course and exams if you are employed but earn less than £20,319 per year. Where fees apply, we operate the following categories:

A	Full fee (depending on eligibility and/or non Warwickshire resident)
B	Discounted fee (50% for learners aged 66 or over)
C	Fully remitted (FREE for learners in receipt of qualifying benefits. Please check if you're eligible)

We accept learners aged 19 or over on 31/08/2023. Most learners are required to have been permanently resident in the UK for the last 3 years. If you do not meet these criteria please contact us. We are not funded to work with learners living in the West Midlands Combined Authority area. If you pay your council tax to Coventry, Birmingham, Solihull, Walsall, Sandwell, Dudley or Wolverhampton please contact us for more information as different fee rates may apply.

How to Enrol? There are four easy ways to enrol:

1. Online: by visiting our website at www.warwickshire.gov.uk/acl or scan this code:- and follow the 'Booking onto a course' link to search available courses by name. You can then fill in our online enrolment form to apply for a course.

*All Maths & English Classes are free. Whether you need to gain necessary qualifications or simply want to improve your skills. Please talk to our staff who can advise you on the best course for your needs.

Make an initial application through our website. A tutor will contact you and invite you for an assessment and discuss your needs before allocating you to an appropriate class.

How do I apply? Eligibility criteria needs to be met so please enquire and check if you have the right residency to apply. Make an initial application through our website. A tutor will contact you and invite you for an assessment and discuss your needs. Although our courses are free, there may be a charge for exams fees. You will be required to show evidence of your residency during your assessment, which will be carried out face to face at one of our centres. ESOL courses are in high demand therefore places are limited.

Learning for Learners with Learning Disabilities/Difficulties (LLDD)

Our Active Learning programme is a suite of courses for adults with learning disabilities and/or learning difficulties. Our courses promote independence, build confidence and develop new skills. Does this sound of interest to you or someone you support? Here are some of the key facts:

Family Learning

Family Learning is learning that takes place among family members including parents, grandparents, and carers. It's about discovering and exploring things together; learning in a relaxed atmosphere and is an opportunity for parents and carers to discover how their children learn and develop.

Some Family Learning courses are for adults and children together, while others are just for adults. All of our courses are free, with resources provided.

We run courses across Warwickshire, in a variety of settings, including Schools, Nurseries, Children and Family Centres and Community Venues. Some of our courses are 'open to the community' and some are 'invitation only' for parents with children attending specific settings.

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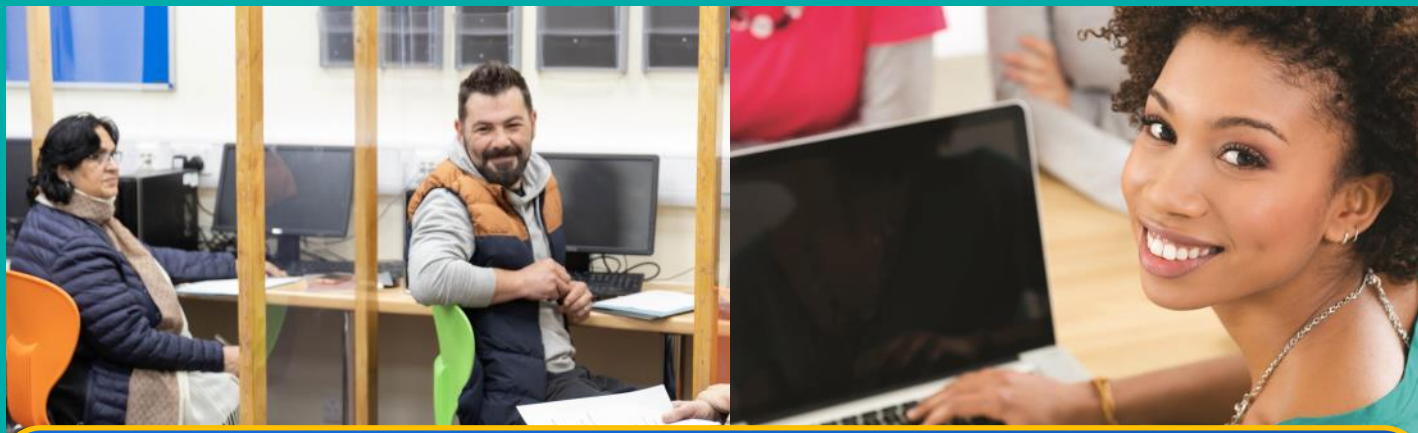


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Our expert tutors are on hand to support you to become confident with technology. Our courses are designed for complete beginners to advanced learners.
