## Preventing Radicalisation Training

1. Prevent Update Training - covering the Prevent Duty, recognising radicalisation risks and the help & support available
2. Prevent Online Grooming - covering the risks of online games and social media platforms
3. DSL Prevent Training - a half-day session looking at the Prevent Duty and education
