

The Procurement Act 2023

The Procurement Act 2023 significantly impacts procurement and contract management in the UK public sector by introducing a new regime that aims to simplify, streamline, and make public procurement more transparent, encompassing the entire contract lifecycle from initial market engagement to contract management and performance monitoring, with a focus on greater openness for suppliers, particularly smaller businesses, and stricter accountability for contracting authorities.

It's a big responsibility that can be challenging at times, but this is what drives us to succeed and achieve. At Warwickshire County Council, you'll improve the county and see just how much of a meaningful difference you make to its people.

We trust and empower you to build relationships, take responsibility and make decisions, whilst leading by example at all times. We're not rigid in how or where we work. We're flexible and know there are many ways to do a job well.


