Role Purpose

- To drive an accessible minibus (up to 16 seats) to safely transport adults and children including those with additional support needs or SEND to day-care centres and schools in Warwickshire
- To provide a demand responsive transport service for the public every weekday (Full-time roles only)
- To act as a Passenger Assistant when required
- To work in any part of the county as and when required.

Role Responsibilities

1. Drive an accessible minibus, transporting children and adults to school, day services and other establishments.
2. Ensure the safety and comfort of passengers during the journey, and that their needs are met in accordance with risk assessments, with consideration of safeguarding reporting and concerns.
3. Maintain accurate and clear records relating to the vehicles and the operation of the service.

4. Ensure vehicles are maintained and cleaned in accordance with the County Council's operating licence.
5. Carry out health and safety responsibilities in accordance with WCC processes and procedures.
6. Other related duties as determined by the County Council.
