

Enhanced COVID-19 Testing

Warwickshire County Council is introducing additional testing measures in and around the Abbey and Wembrook wards in Nuneaton after a small number of cases of a variant of concern were identified in the area.

To support testing, our teams will be going door to door in the Abbey ward from Thursday 20 May from 10.30am and 6.30pm to offer a free PCR test kit for residents to carry out at home. This will run over a two-week period. The tests are for all residents, age 2 or over regardless of whether they have symptoms of COVID-19 or not.

In addition to door knocking, there will be a number of community collect and drop sites where people can collect tests for themselves, members of their family or for someone they know who is not able to leave the home. This programme will run for 2 weeks.

Collect and Drop instructions will be issued with the testing kits, and tests must be carried out safely in the home and not in the car or on the roadside. Once completed, tests must be put it into the sealed box provided and returned to the location it was collected from.
