#### **Energy Bills Discount Scheme**

The government has recently announced a new business energy scheme - the Energy Bills Discount Scheme (EBDS) - which succeeds the current EBRS scheme from April 2023 - March 2024.

All Early Years providers will continue to be eligible as they are now (childminders continue to get domestic energy support).

**EBRS Scheme**:  $\cdot$  Unit costs of energy capped at £211 per MwH for electricity, and £75 per MwH for gas

**EBDS Scheme**: • Unit costs of energy discounted by:

- £19.61 per MwH for electricity if wholesale costs exceed £302 per MwH
- £6.07 per MwH for gas if wholesale costs exceed £107 per MwH

The overall level of govt support will be capped at £5.5bn

#### **Tax Free Childcare**

In 2022 the latest survey of Warwickshire childcare providers identified that 89% of providers are now promoting Tax Free Childcare to parents which is an increase of 4.8% since the last survey. https://api.warwickshire.gov.uk/documents/WCCC-808477336-717

Millions of families remain entitled to this support with paying for their childcare costs alongside accessing the funded entitlements for 2, 3 and 4 year olds however information identifies that take up is still limited by many families.

Tax Free Childcare is a UK wide offer. Eligible parents with children under 12 can access up to  $\pounds 2,000$  per child, per year, towards their childcare costs (or up to  $\pounds 4,000$  for disabled children under 17).

Providers will be able to receive Tax Free Childcare payments from their customers once they have signed up to Tax Free Childcare. For more information on Tax Free Childcare please <u>click here</u>.

#### NEW \*Government response to the consultation on national funding

**formulae and increase in funding**—Following the DfE consultation over the summer 2022 on updating and amending the national funding formulae that determine local authorities funding rates for the free childcare entitlements. Over 400 responses to the consultation provided broad support for our proposals and we have implemented almost all of the changes we had set out. The Government response to the consultation has been published today, and explains the changes made to the formulae, that have been used to determine next years hourly rates.
