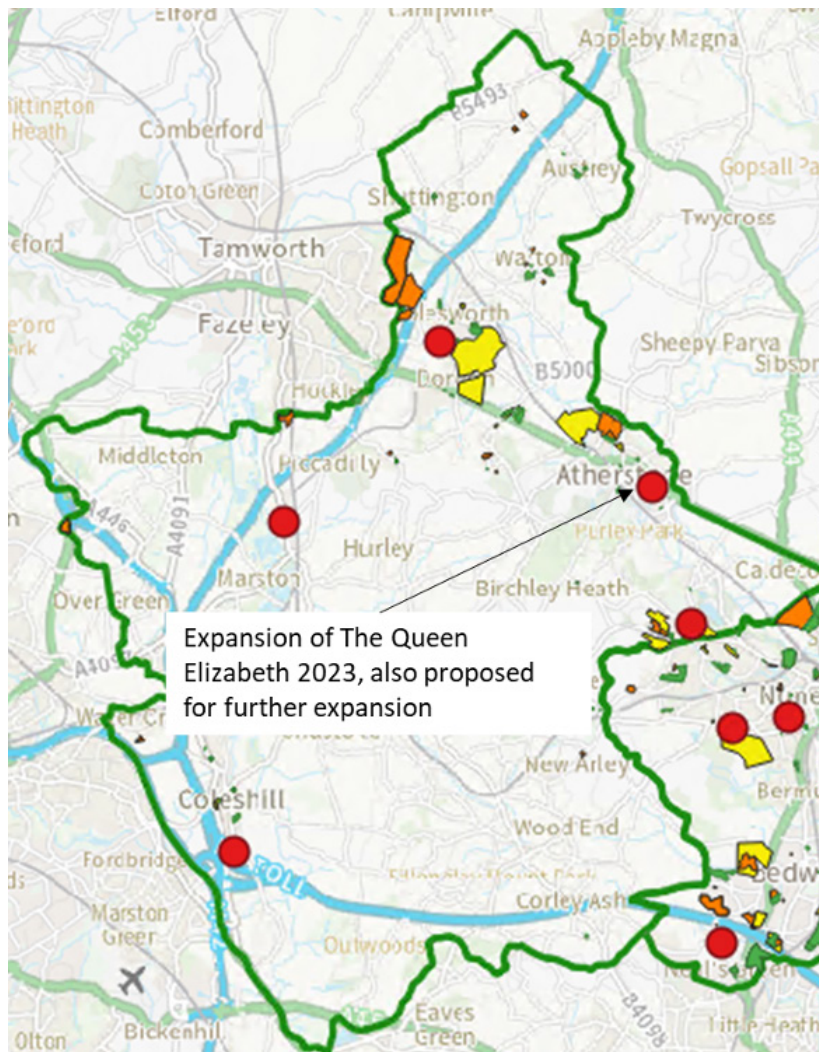

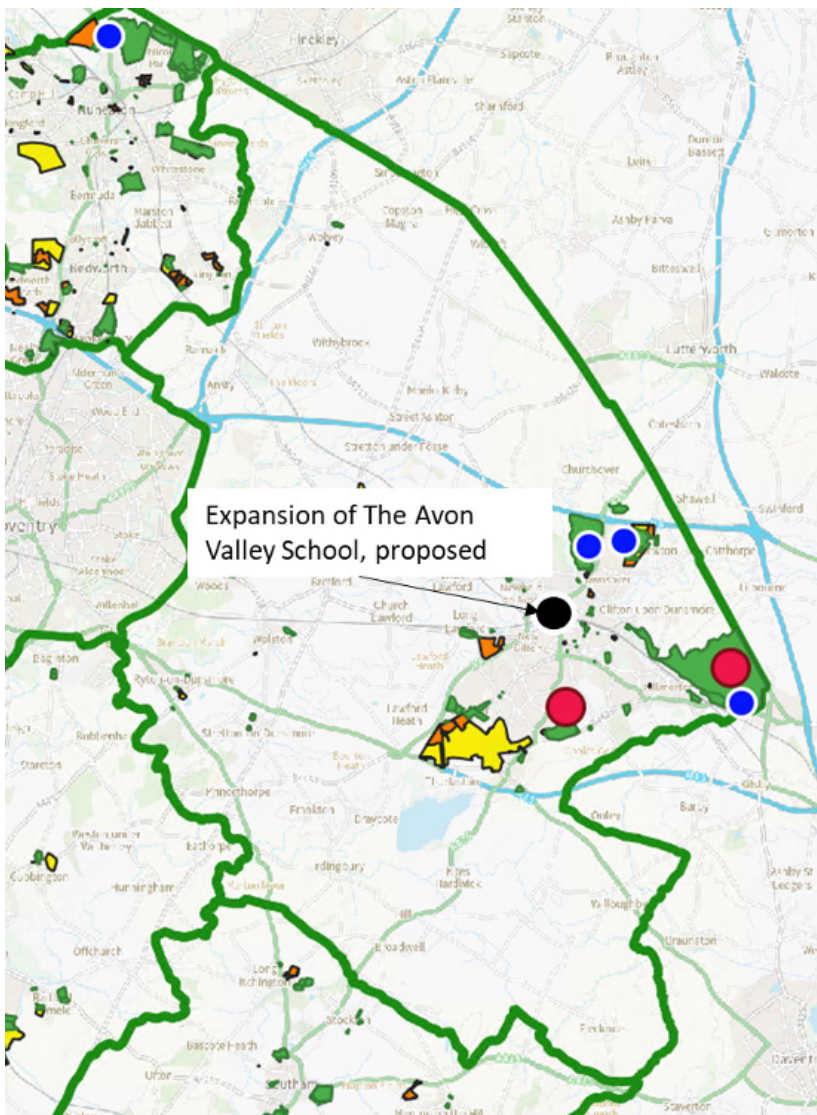
- New primary schools - Lower Farm 2018, proposed: Top Farm, Callendar Farm and Arbury

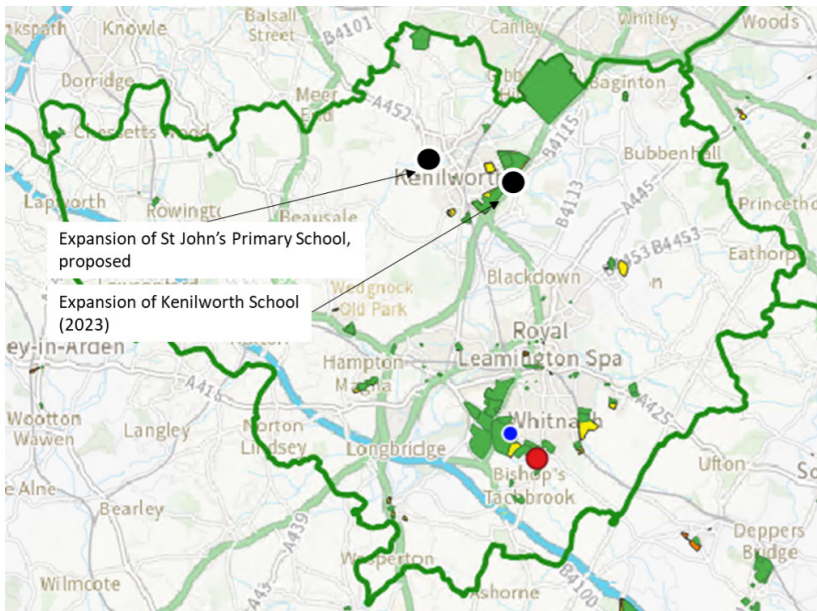

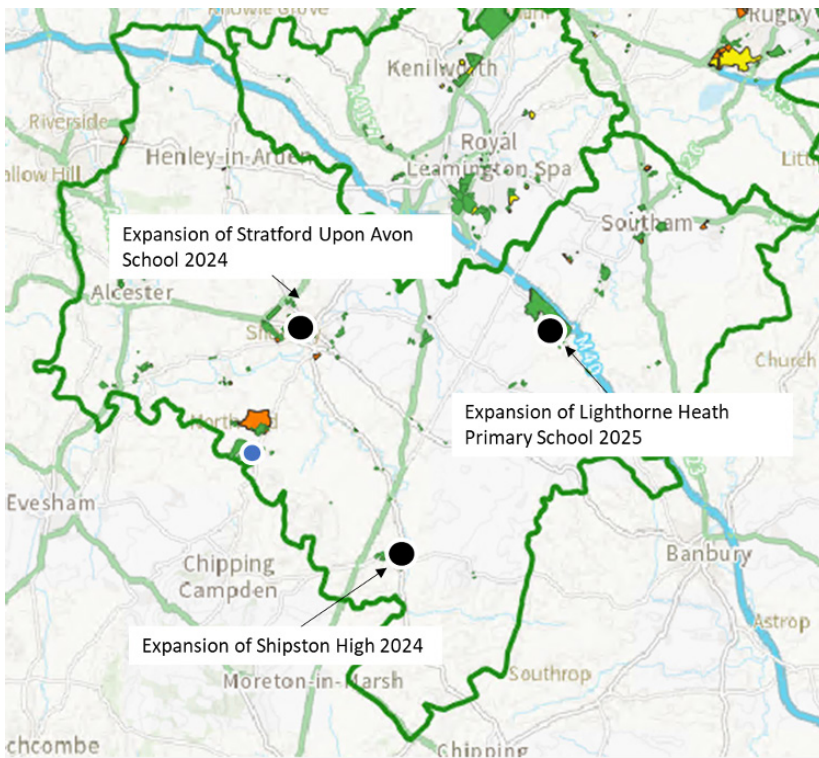

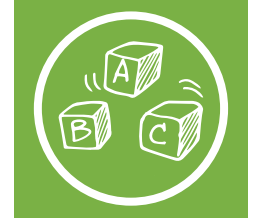

North Warwickshire and South Leicestershire College (NWSLC)

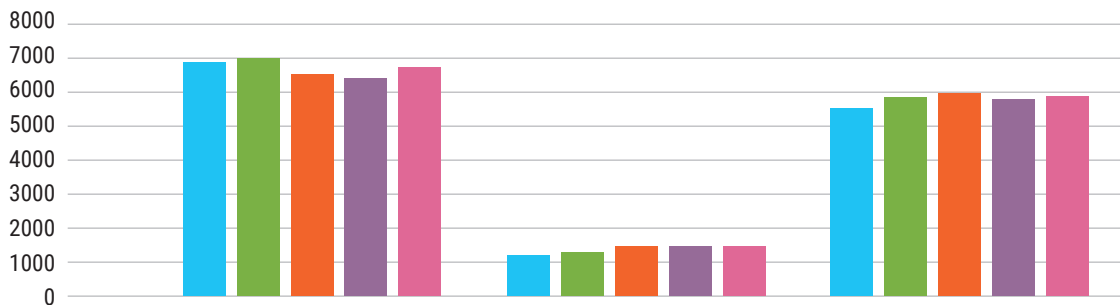
