2026/2027 Early Education Entitlements Funding Rates

Please find below a table which confirms the Early Education Entitlement funding rates for the financial year 2026/2027, highlighted in green.

For 2026/2027, local authorities are required to pass through at least 97% of funding for each of the following entitlement funding streams individually:

- Under 2s working parents
- 2-year-old disadvantaged offer
- 2-year-old working parents
- 3 & 4-year-old entitlements

Warwickshire County Council can confirm that the retained 3% of funds are utilised to cover the provision of inclusion funding, including contributing to specialist teachers and support. Alongside this, allocations are used for safeguarding and quality support and ensuring the necessary infrastructure and systems are in place to manage relevant funding applications, process and pay all providers, childminders and schools as required and deliver the associated support.

Warwickshire County Council engaged with the Early Years Partnership Working Group on 7 January 2026 who provided their recommendation. This was reviewed by Schools Forum on 15 January 2026. Cabinet approved the rates on 27 January 2026.
