Casualty Reduction Scheme Overview

Site Description

The priority major A road subject to this study is the A422 Banbury Road.

The A422 Banbury, Kineton, is a single carriageway, two-way road running from East to West and West to East, with a crossroads intersection with 2 x C class carriageways of Tysoe Road, running North to South and South to North. The A422 has priority at the crossroads intersection. The A422 and Tysoe Road (North) are subject to a 60mph speed limit, and Tysoe Road (South) is subject to a 50mph speed limit. The area in question is rural with one commercial property on the A422, one residential/commercial property on Tysoe Road (North).



Collision data

A total of 4 Personal Injury Collisions have been recorded resulting in 9 casualties.

- 2 x slight in severity
- 2 x serious in severity

The majority of collisions occurred as a result of vehicles on Tysoe Road failing to give way at the junction with the A422.

WORKS IMPLEMENTED AS PART OF THE IMPROVMENT SCHEME.

The improvement works consisted of the installation of junction warning signage, improvements to existing, and installation of additional, giveway signage, remarking junction giveway markings, and the provision of SLOW road text.
