## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTIONS 9 & 10**

## THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LANDSDOWNE PLACE, RUGBY) (PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) ORDER 2025

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), the effect of which will be to continue an experimental order on Lansdowne Place, Rugby as follows:-

1. Prohibit vehicular traffic in Lansdowne Place, Rugby, for its entire length of 143m, between Monday and Friday between the hours of 8:15 – 9:15am and 2:30-3:30pm during School Term Time (following Warwickshire Term Dates)

The Order commences on 12<sup>th</sup> May 2025 and contains exemptions for the emergency services, blue badge holders and permit holders.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of the experimental order, plans showing the lengths of road affected, the associated traffic calming proposals and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick during usual opening hours and on the Council's website. <a href="https://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/news/20208/rugby-borough">https://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/news/20208/rugby-borough</a>
