Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

**The Warwickshire County Council (Lansdowne Place, Rugby) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles)
Order 2025**

1. Statement of Reasons

- 1.1. Warwickshire County Council intends to make permanent an Experimental Traffic Regulation Order the effect of which will be to continue to close Lansdowne Place, for its entire length of 143m, to all vehicular traffic between Monday to Friday, between the hours of 8:15 – 9:15am and 2:30 – 3:30pm, during School Term Time (following Warwickshire Term Dates).
- 1.2. This scheme has been carried out to determine the positive effects of promoting Active Travel and to reduce parking and traffic congestion in and around Lansdowne Place during school drop off and pick up times.
- 1.3. Warwickshire County Council has considered the effectiveness or otherwise of the experimental order during its operation and has determined that the scheme has a positive impact on air quality, assists in the avoidance of danger to persons or traffic around the school gates and promotes Active Travel to and from the school. A decision has therefore been taken to make a Traffic Regulation Order to continue the prohibition indefinitely.
- 1.4. The Order will apply to the lengths of road referred to in Schedule 1 below and as illustrated on plan TR11429.

2. Schedule 1

Closure of Lansdowne Place, Rugby

From its junction with Portland Road, for a distance of 143 metres.
