5-11 years Vaccine template which can used for communications with parents/guardians.

All children aged 5-11 can now have a COVID-19 vaccination. For most children, this will involve two doses of the Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine, 12 weeks apart. The vaccine reduces your child's risk of catching COVID-19 and passing it on to others. You can get your child vaccinated:

- By booking an appointment online at a vaccination centre or pharmacy
- By attending a walk-in centre (no appointment needed)

You can book a second dose from 24 hours after your child's first dose – you will be offered appointments in 12 weeks' time.
