Appendix 4 – Summary of 16-18 education providers

Post 16 Education provision in Schools

In recent years the location and supply of school sixth form provision in Warwickshire has remained largely unchanged. Schools set their own sixth form admissions criteria, manage their own sixth form admissions and the level and number of courses on offer.

There are however, isolated instances of demand within sixth forms which occurs across the county. The individual schools have responded to this pressure by providing additional places and have sought funding from government funding streams. Numbers are expected to continue to rise in line with current predictions for secondary places.

FE colleges have entry requirements for their programmes of study and they manage their own admissions. If an FE college sees an increased demand for placements on a specific programme, then they would determine if an additional course could be delivered (this would be dependent on a number of factors including; staffing availability, class size viability and if there were available DfE Post 16 places within the organisation).

DfE funded places are allocated to Post 16 settings and can be taken up by learners from outside of the county. Many Post 16 settings have campuses beyond county boundaries, meaning their place funding is allocated at the whole setting level, rather than broken down by Local Authority. This must be considered in Post 16 forecasting. Warwickshire County Council will continue to work alongside schools, colleges and partners to ensure that the future forecast demand is met.


The funding of new post-16 places rests with the DfE (the previous body responsible for this was Education Skills Funding Agency which was merged into the DfE in April 2025). Where there is a gap in provision, the DfE will either consider requests from existing providers that are rated Good or Outstanding by Ofsted or will seek new provision from independent learning providers (ILPs). The DfE applies standard criteria to ensure that gaps are well evidenced prior to securing additional places and will only seek to fund new provision where it adds value and is a high-quality addition to the existing offer for young people.

As academies, the King Edward Sixth Form College and school sixth forms are required to submit a business case to the DfE, via the Regional Schools Commissioner, if their numbers are to grow by 50 or more students.

Due to the nature of students travelling across county it is not possible to break down further the funded student numbers by Districts and Boroughs.








Post 16 attainment



Warwickshire continues to outperform both national and regional averages in the percentage of pupils achieving grade 5 or above in English and Maths at KS4. In 2025 (provisional results), 49.6% of Warwickshire pupils met this benchmark, compared to 45.2% nationally and 41.4% in the West Midlands.





Between 2023 and 2024, Stratford on Avon was the only district and borough to see an increase between 2023 and 2024 for the 'grade 5 or above' measure. The percentage of students achieving this rose by over 2 percentage points from 58.4% to 60.7%

Whilst lower scoring overall, the same measure in North Warwickshire and Nuneaton and Bedworth only saw marginal declines of 0.2 percentage points from 34.2% to 34.0% and 40.5% to 40.3% respectively.

The largest decline was in Rugby where the fall was nearly 5 percentage points from 54.9% to 50.2%.
