Pursue opportunities to use existing accommodation more effectively, future proof new provision and achieve best value for money.




#### **Priority 3:** Partnership and collaboration

Communication and discussion with stakeholders and partners on proposals, ensuring always that the council's sufficiency duties take precedence.




# Priority 4: Managing and supporting change
