Introduction

Overview

This Directory details Alternative Provision (AP) settings in and around Warwickshire. All settings are either registered as schools or College or have been assessed as appropriate non-school AP through our Quality Assurance programme.

AP is temporary education for pupils requiring additional support away from their school.

Schools should operate a graduated approach to meet pupils' needs, and wherever possible provide support at school rather than off-site. However, in some circumstances AP can help pupils re-engage with education, rebuild confidence, and develop academic, social or vocational skills.

AP placements should have a planned end date and a clear focus on progress and reintegration. Occasionally AP may be used to support transition into a new setting or pathway.

Settings are grouped by District Area.

The programmes available at each setting are categorised as:

Part-Time (Whole Year)	An 'alternative curriculum' - usually no more than one day a week, typically a course across the full academic year and working towards a qualification.
Part-Time (Short Stay)	A programme delivered for up to two days per week, usually up to 12 weeks, designed to assess & address specific identified needs.
Full-Time (Short Stay)	A full-time programme delivered up to 12 weeks, provided away from the pupil's school and with a focus on planned reintegration.

When making placements, schools should be aware of [Regulations Regarding Out-of-School Settings](#), to ensure settings are not inappropriately providing full-time education.

Quality Assurance

Most of the settings are non-school 'unregistered' AP.

These settings are assessed regularly through WCC's Quality Assurance Programme to ensure compliance with the [National Minimum Standards for Non-school Alternative Provision](#).

The date of each setting's latest Quality Assurance Assessment is shown at the end of their Directory entry.

Providers should make their QA reports available to schools on request.



New Settings

Some settings have approached the Local Authority for inclusion in the Directory, but we have not yet been able to do a full Quality Assurance assessment. We aim to complete all QA assessments during the Autumn Term 2026.

In the meantime, we have included brief information and contact details for these settings ([Pages 42 & 43](#)) and schools are advised to undertake their own checks before using these provisions.

Outreach and On-line Providers

Occasionally schools may wish to use peripatetic services such as tuition and mentoring.

We are gathering information about these providers and this will be included in the September edition of the AP Directory.

Schools should undertake their own due diligence such services.

Arranging AP and Oversight of Placements

Schools should approach providers directly to arrange placements and are responsible for:

1. The safeguarding, wellbeing, attendance and progress of their pupils, even when education is delivered off-site
2. Ensuring the placement is appropriate for the specific needs of each pupil
3. Monitoring & oversight of the placement
4. Ensuring a risk assessment is undertaken for each placement

Warwickshire AP providers are required to use the Council's CLM database to record attendance. Schools should use this to monitor and track attendance at AP.

Fees

Fees should be clearly agreed with the provider prior to each placement.

In some circumstances, Warwickshire County Council may agree to contribute towards the fees being paid by schools. Please discuss this with the EHC Plan Co-ordinator or EET Learning Mentor
