## Safeguarding and Early Help training for Warwickshire education settings

Warwickshire County Council and Health have been working collaboratively with schools and Warwickshire Parent Carer Voice to develop a training model to support provision for SEND in education settings. This information is focused on the training for Safeguarding and Early Help. Due to the nature of the **Safeguarding and Early Help** training and the legislative requirements of some of the training we have not categorised it as we have with the other training areas.

Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) Newly qualified Initial DSL	WCC - Safeguarding Team	1 full day and half day	£100	Each educational setting (nursery, school or FE college) should have a minimum of two SLT members who are designated as safeguarding leads (DSL). They will provide support to staff members to carry out their safeguarding duties and who will liaise closely with other services such as Early Help and Children's Social Care. In addition, DSLs can be supported by Deputy Designated Safeguarding Leads (DDSLs) as long as they are all trained to the same level as the DSL. DDSLs can be members of staff in other roles. This Initial DSL training should be followed up by ongoing training through the networks and update training every two years.	Safeguarding Training Programme

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Reflective supervision for DSLs	WCC - Safeguarding Team	Full Day	£100	This course is for headteachers and DSLs with at least one year of DSL experience. It is designed to provide a wider repertoire of options for effective supervisory conversations in respect of safeguarding issues. Several ideas and techniques will be shared that can be used to inform and develop practice. Staff will be supported to make safeguarding practice as safe as possible for everyone.	<u>Safeguarding Training</u> <u>Programme</u>
Understanding today's children	WCC - Safeguarding Team	Half day	Free	This course aims to ensure delegates understand the origins of behaviour and how this can present. Domestic abuse training	WCC - Safeguarding Team	Half day	£40	Informed by the Domestic Abuse Act 2021, this training focuses on many aspects of domestic abuse, providing DSLs with the knowledge to recognise diverse ways children and families experience abuse, such as coercive and controlling behaviour. Protective Behaviours	WCC - Safeguarding Team	1 day	£90 per person. Price for whole school training TBC on application.	All schools using Protective Behaviours would ideally have all staff trained in the approach to consistently apply the ethos in all work with children when considering; safeguarding, supporting emotional wellbeing, applying trauma informed practice and promoting safe relationships.	<u>Safeguarding Training</u> <u>Programme</u>
Safer Recruitment training	WCC - Early Help	1.5 days - refresher is a 1 day course	£150	It is vital that as part of a whole school or college approach to safeguarding, that governing bodies and proprietors create a culture that safeguards and promotes the welfare of children. As part of this, it is important that they adopt robust recruitment procedures that deter and prevent people who are unsuitable to work with children from applying for or securing employment, or volunteering opportunities in schools and colleges (KCSiE para. 206). Please ensure that at least one member of your interview panel has undergone this training. Due to updates in the training is it recommended that a refresher is undertaken every 3-4 years.	<u>Safeguarding Training</u> <u>Programme</u>
