# iPhone Quick Reference Guide



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

**Please note:** some of the buttons on the mobile maybe located in a different place depending on the iPhone model you have.

Status Icon	What it means
	Portrait Orientation The iPhone is in portrait orientation mode but not locked in that mode.
	Portrait Orientation lock The iPhone screen is locked in portrait orientation.
	Alarm An alarm is set.
	Location Services An item is using Location Services.
	Bluetooth Blue or white icon: Bluetooth is on & paired with a device. Grey icon: Bluetooth is on. If iPhone is paired with a device, the device may be out of range or turned off. No icon: Bluetooth is turned off.
	Bluetooth battery Shows the battery level of a paired Bluetooth device.
	Battery Shows the iPhone battery level or charging status.
	Lock Your iPhone is locked.
	Play Shows that a song, audiobook or podcast is playing.

## Turn the phone on

Press and hold the power button (Sleep/Wake button) until the device begins to turn on.

## Making a call



Tap the phone icon. You can then either:

- Select from an existing contact on your phone by tapping the **'Contacts'** icon, searching for the relevant contact & then tap on the phone icon to call.



- Type in a new number to dial by tapping the **'Keypad'** icon, typing in the number & then tap the green **'Call button'**.



## Sending a text





Tap the message icon.

Tap the new message symbol.



Enter a recipient (either a contact name or a mobile phone number) in the **'To'** field.


Text message box will be then available.



Enter the message you wish to send.


Tap the **'Send'** icon. Your message will be sent.

## Adding a contact




Tap the 'Contacts' icon.

Then choose the '+' symbol in the top right.



Fill in the 'New Contact' form show to the right with the details. Use the green '+' icon to add details within each field.



**Note:** you can add further information for your contact including email address, home address , etc.

Once you have completed, tap 'Done' .

## Status Icons

The icons in the status bar at the top of the screen give information about iPhone.

Status Icon		What it means
•••••	Cell Signal	You're in range of the cellular network & can make & receive calls. If there is no signal, 'No Service' appears.
✈️	Airplane mode	Airplane mode is on—you can't make phone calls & other wireless functions may be disabled.
3G 4G	UMTS (Universal Mobile Telecommunications System)	Your carrier's 3G/4G network is available & iPhone can connect to the Internet over that network.
GPRS	GPRS (General Packet Radio Service)	Your carrier's GPRS network is available & iPhone can connect to the Internet over that network.
Wi-Fi	Wi-Fi call	iPhone is making a call over Wi-Fi.
📶	Wi-Fi	iPhone is connect to the Internet over a Wi-Fi network.
🌙	Do Not Disturb	'Do Not Disturb' is turned on.
📶	Personal Hotspot	iPhone is providing a Personal Hotspot for another device.
🔄	Syncing	iPhone is syncing with iTunes.
🌟	Network activity	Shows that there is network activity. Some third-party apps may also use it to show an active process.
➡️	Call Forwarding	Call forwarding is set up.
VPN	VPN	You are connected to a network using VPN.
