Creating an Apple ID Quick Reference Guide





This guide will provide instruction on how to create an Apple ID on an Apple Device for a Warwickshire County Council user in order to download apps from the Apple App Store.

Preparing Your Device for Creation of Apple ID

Before starting the process make sure the device is not signed into the iTunes and App Store with any account (Apple ID).

IMPORTANT THINGS TO NOTE BEFORE YOU START!

• Make sure the email address used to create the Apple ID is your Warwickshire County Council address.

(e.g. yourname@warwickshire.gov.uk)

- When request for address and phone details, please enter work address and telephone number.
 (e.g. Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, CV34 4RL – 01926-123123)
- Make sure the instructions are followed exactly as stated in the video with regards to downloading a free app before creation of the Apple ID otherwise your personal credit card details will have been entered.

In the event the processes are not followed, there is no way of starting the Apple ID creation process again with the same email address.

• Make sure the email address entered is spelt correctly otherwise the whole process will have to be repeated.
