Rugby football.



Warwickshire has great road, rail and air links and our friendly staff will guide you through from start to finish.

Whether you are looking for the intimacy of just a few friends, a close family gathering or the largest of celebrations, simply select the setting that suits you from a range of hotels, restaurants, stately homes, castles, golf clubs, race courses, historic buildings and registration offices and look forward to a celebration to remember.

Registration staff will discuss your individual needs and wishes and guide you through the legal formalities. They will work to ensure that your ceremony runs as smoothly as possible, leaving you with memories to treasure.







# CIVIL MARRIAGE AND CIVIL PARTNERSHIP PEREMONIES

A CIVIL CEREMONY CAN TAKE PLACE AT A REGISTRATION OFFICE OR OTHER PREMISES APPROVED BY THE LOCAL AUTHORITY (HOTEL OR STATELY HOME, FOR EXAMPLE). YOU MAY CHOOSE TO HAVE YOUR MARRIAGE OR CIVIL PARTNERSHIP CELEBRATION AT ANY REGISTRATION OFFICE OR APPROVED PREMISES IN ENGLAND OR WALES.

However, for a ceremony in an approved premises, you will also need to make arrangements with the venue in question. There are fees payable for the attendance of registration staff at your ceremony, both at a registration office and at a venue. In addition you will both need to give formal notice of marriage or civil partnership in the district where you both live.

#### LEGAL FORMALITIES

Unless you are holding your ceremony in a Church of England or a Church in Wales, you will both be required to attend personally at the registration office for the district(s) in which you

both live to give a notice of marriage or civil partnership to the Superintendent Registrar. Both of you must have lived in that registration district in England or Wales for at least eight days immediately before your notice appointment.

If you both live in the same district, you should ideally attend your local registration office together to give notice. If you live in different registration districts, then each of you will need to give notice in your own district, preferably as near to each other as possible.

A fee will be charged for giving notice and documents will need to be produced - we will advise you what you will need to bring. After giving your notices, there is a variable waiting period before your ceremony can take place.

Once given, a notice of marriage or civil partnership remains valid for one year for the venue stated. If one of you is not a national of the European Union please contact your local office for advice.

#### PLEASE NOTE

Your ceremony cannot go ahead unless the legal formalities have been completed. You and your partner must give notice in person – no one can do so on your behalf. Where a provisional booking for a ceremony has been made, it is essential that formal notice is given within the timescale requested by the registration office to ensure that your booking remains secure.

#### RELIGIOUS CEREMONIES

If you wish to have a religious ceremony in a Church of England or Church in Wales, you should speak to the vicar about the arrangements. If you wish to have a religious ceremony of any other denomination, you should first arrange to see the minister or other person in charge at the building to discuss your requirements, before contacting your local registration office to complete the legal preliminaries. It is usually only possible to have a ceremony in a religious building situated in a district where one or both of you live. You may however hold your ceremony in a religious building in a district in which neither of you lives, if either or both of you usually worship in that building.

The religious building will generally have a person appointed to register your ceremony. If this is not the case, you must ensure that a registrar from the district in which the building is situated is present at your ceremony by prior arrangement. If you are unsure whether you need a registrar to attend, please contact your local registration office for advice.

#### REGISTRATION OFFICES

Warwickshire has five ceremony rooms located in the main registration offices throughout the county, the details of which can be found below. All our ceremony rooms have disabled access and are decorated to a high standard. You can view photographs of our venues on our website at www.warwickshire.gov.uk/registrations.

A provisional booking at one of these offices can be made by telephone or in person but you must still give legal notice in the district where you live no more than twelve months in advance of your ceremony. We will be pleased to offer you a provisional booking up to two years before your chosen ceremony date.





# PLANNING AHEAD

We know that planning a wedding ceremony can be both time consuming and stressful, so here are a few helpful suggestions on what you may need to arrange before the ceremony to ensure that everything runs smoothly.

#### 12 - 24 MONTHS BEFORE

- Book your ceremony venue
- Book the reception venue and book the registrars
- Book the caterers
- Look into wedding insurance

#### 9 - 12 MONTHS BEFORE

- Arrange an appointment to give your legal notice of marriage (Please note that this can be no more than 12 months prior to the ceremony. Once notice is given this confirms your booking)
- Choose your attendants and close wedding party
- Book your photographer and / or videographer
- Order your invitations or start making them yourself
- Plan your outfits
- Book the entertainment
- Send out save the date cards as soon as you have your date, to avoid holiday clashes
- Decide on what sort of transport, if any, you will be using on the day and book for the ceremony and afterwards

#### 6 MONTHS BEFORE

- Organise your wedding gift list
- Plan and book your honeymoon
- If you want to book your honeymoon in your new name you will need to apply for a passport in that name

- Send out invitations
- Arrange stag/hen parties
- Book your wedding day hair appointment
- Choose menu options for the reception and order the cake
- Choose your florist and place the order
- Buy rings

#### 3 MONTHS BEFORE

- Finalise honeymoon arrangements
- Book overnight hotel if necessary
- Send list of local accommodation to guests who may need it
- Buy attendants presents
- Pay the balance of your wedding ceremony fees
- If you have booked your honeymoon in your new name remember to book your PD2 appointment for your new passport. Appointments can be made with the Registration team carrying out your ceremony
- Reminder: Make sure you have given notice of the marriage

#### 1 MONTH BEFORE

- Chase up guests who have not replied
- Give final guest list to caterers and venue and arrange seating plan
- Have any final clothes fittings
- Check transport arrangements
- Prepare thank you cards for presents you may receive
- Send back your Ceremony Planning Form to the Registration Service

#### 2 WEEKS BEFORE

- Work out rough timetable for the day and run through it with the wedding party
- Wear your wedding shoes around the house
- Give your outfits a final check for fit
- Ensure all hired clothes are collected on time
- Order currency if travelling abroad
- Pack for honeymoon

#### ON THE DAY

- Delegate important jobs to the wedding party
- Remember to allow time for your pre-ceremony interviews
- Drink plenty of water
- Try to relax


#### RUGBY – BLOXAM ROOM

# AN APPROVED PREMISES CEREMONY

IN ADDITION TO OUR REGISTRATION OFFICES WE HAVE AROUND 85 EXCELLENT PREMISES APPROVED BY WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL FOR THE SOLEMNISATION OF CIVIL PARTNERSHIPS AND MARRIAGES.

The exact number of venues is constantly changing so check our website for the most up to date listing at www.warwickshire.gov.uk/registrations.


If you choose to hold your ceremony in one of these approved premises you should initially contact the venue of your choice and make provisional arrangements for the date and time of your ceremony. You should then immediately contact the registration office in the area the venue is located to ensure that registration staff are available to conduct your ceremony.

In Warwickshire it is possible to provisionally book your ceremony up to two years in advance even though you cannot give legal notice at that time. This will enable you to make other arrangements connected with your ceremony. Registration staff will be pleased to advise you.

Fees for attending ceremonies at approved premises differ from the fees at registration offices. Please see the website for the current fees.













# WHAT HAPPENS ON THE DAY?

#### ARRIVAL AND MEETING THE REGISTRAR

You are both required to be ready for a pre-ceremony interview by the registrar before your ceremony can begin - this interview is essential to ensure that all of your personal details are correct for the registration of your marriage or civil partnership. Interviews can take place separately or together. Your guests will be seated whilst this interview is taking place and so it may be useful for you to appoint an usher who can help co-ordinate this.

It is very important that you and your guests arrive in plenty of time - it is probable that the registrars will have other ceremonies to attend on the same day and so we are unable to delay the start of your celebration so that we do not risk being late for any other couple's booking. If you are late for your ceremony, we may not be able to proceed as planned, so to avoid any disappointment, please make sure that you have allowed enough time to get ready and arrive at the venue calmly and promptly.

#### WITNESSES

On the day of your ceremony, the law requires that you bring with you at least two other people who are prepared to witness your ceremony and sign the marriage register or civil partnership schedule. They may be relatives, friends or colleagues who are able to speak and understand English, as they must be able to comprehend what is taking place and testify to what they have seen and heard.

#### NUMBER OF GUESTS

Of course, in addition to your witnesses, you may wish to invite your family and friends to your celebration. Each ceremony room will be licensed for a particular number of guests and vou must adhere to these numbers as they are laid down according to fire regulations. No extra guests are permitted to stand in the ceremony room, unless stated. Please note that any children over 2 years old are counted as individual guests and must be included in your overall numbers.







#### **INTERPRETER**

It is essential that both you and your two witnesses fully understand the content of your marriage or civil partnership ceremony, and therefore the full legal implications of such a celebration. If there are any language difficulties, you must provide a suitable interpreter to attend with you who must sign as a witness and is satisfied that you understand the nature and purpose of the ceremony.

#### FEES AND OTHER INFORMATION

There are legally set fees for giving notice of marriage or civil partnership and there are additional costs for the attendance of registrars to perform your ceremony. You will be advised of these costs when you book your registrar attendance; alternatively they can be found on the registration section of the Warwickshire County Council website - please visit www.warwickshire.gov.uk/registrations.

#### CANCELLATION POLICY

In the event that you need to cancel a ceremony, you will be required to notify us in writing.

If you cancel:

- more than eight weeks before the ceremony date, you will receive a full refund (excluding nonrefundable booking fees).
- between three and eight weeks before the ceremony date, you will receive a 50% refund (excluding non-refundable booking fees).
- less than three weeks before the ceremony date (or failure to cancel), there will be no refund.

You may wish to consider taking out an appropriate insurance policy in case your ceremony has to be cancelled or postponed due to unforeseen circumstances.





# PERSONALISING YOUR CEREMONY

THE PERSONALISATION OF ALL CEREMONIES IS ENCOURAGED AND WE ARE ALWAYS HAPPY TO DISCUSS YOUR OWN IDEAS, OR PRESENT OUR AVAILABLE CHOICES TO YOU.

The marriage ceremony includes the required legal declaratory and contracting words but you may choose additional words, readings and music if you wish. All other ceremonies can be tailored to your personal wishes, on the understanding that there can be no religious content and the dignity of the occasion should be respected.

If your ceremony is at an approved premise you should check what facilities they have for playing music.

You will receive an options booklet to assist you with your planning which includes a planning form which you should return to the relevant registration office at least four weeks before your ceremony for approval.





# CHANGING YOUR NAME ON OUR PASSPORT

YOU SHOULD THINK CAREFULLY ABOUT WHETHER YOU WISH TO CHANGE YOUR NAME ON YOUR PASSPORT IN ADVANCE OF YOUR CEREMONY DATE OR WHETHER YOU WAIT UNTIL YOU HAVE RETURNED FROM ANY HONEYMOON OR FORFIGN TRIP.

This is because you should ensure that the name on your passport matches the name in which you have booked your travel. Even if you have your marriage or civil partnership certificate with you, some countries may not let you in and some travel companies may not let you board their flights if your name is different on your tickets than on your passport.

You should check with your travel agent or the consulate of the country you plan to visit prior to making the decision to change the name on your passport in advance, particularly if visas are involved.

If you decide to change your name on your passport (to your future married or partnered name) in advance of your ceremony, you can do so up to three months before the ceremony date. Her Majesty's Passport Office (HMPO) will

cancel your old passport and issue you with a new one. But please note: the new passport will be dated to become valid on the day of your ceremony and therefore cannot be used before. Similarly, when IPS cancels your old passport, any visas on that passport may become invalid.

To amend your passport before your ceremony, you need to complete a standard application form but also a form PD2 which you can obtain from the Post Office or download from the internet.

After you have completed your section of the PD2 form, a Superintendent Registrar will also need to complete part of the form. Please take the form into the relevant Registration Office during opening hours and we will gladly do it for you - you do not need to make an

appointment. There is no charge for this service. Alternatively you can post the form to us enclosing a stamped addressed envelope.

If you decide to change your name on your passport after your ceremony when you have returned from any trip overseas, you need only complete a standard application form and send your marriage or civil partnership certificate to IPS with your application – form PD2 is not required.





# RE-REGISTRATION

ACCORDING TO LAW. A CHILD'S BIRTH WILL NEED TO BE RE-REGISTERED IF THE PARENTS HAVE ENTERED INTO A MARRIAGE OR CIVIL PARTNERSHIP WITH EACH OTHER SINCE THE BIRTH.

At this time, a new birth record will be created showing the child as a child of the parents' marriage or civil partnership, replacing the original registration. All future copy birth certificates will be issued from this new record.

#### **MARRIAGE**

To complete the re-registration, both parents need to fill in a form LA1 which can be obtained from any registration office in England or Wales. Once you have both completed and signed the form you should contact the registration office where you would like to have the re-registration appointment. You will need to take your marriage certificate and child's full birth certificate with you to your appointment along with the completed form. If you have more than one child, you will need to complete an LA1 form for each child. If you were married abroad, please contact your local registration office for advice.

#### CIVIL PARTNERSHIP

The General Register Office authorises all re-registrations of children born to same sex couples. Please contact them on 0300 123 1837 to initiate the process.

You do not have to return to the same registration office where you originally registered your child's birth, although it is preferable. The new birth record will still have to be entered in their registers, but if you have moved since your child was born, you can complete a re-registration appointment at the registration office most convenient to your new location. That office will take all of the relevant information from you and forward it on your behalf to the registration office holding the original birth entry for processing – this is called a declaration.

Only one parent needs to attend the re-registration appointment (although both are welcome) and there is no

charge for this service. The only cost that you will incur is if you wish to purchase a new, full birth certificate for your child which you will need for many official purposes, such as passport applications.

You will need to book an appointment to re-register your child or children at any of our Warwickshire Registration Offices and it can only happen after your marriage or civil partnership ceremony has taken place - re-registration cannot be completed in advance.

# RENEWAL OF VOWS CEREMONIES

#### ARE YOU ABOUT TO CELEBRATE THAT SPECIAL MILESTONE ANNIVERSARY: TWENTY-FIVE, FORTY OR EVEN FIFTY YEARS OF MARRIED LIFE?

Do you know somebody close to you, parents or grandparents, who have given you those years of love and support and you wish to help them celebrate a wonderful family occasion? There is no better way of acknowledging the day than preceding the anniversary party with a delightful ceremony to renew those treasured marriage vows.

Maybe, as a younger couple, you held your marriage or civil partnership ceremony abroad in an idyllic tropical setting? Now that you are home and the photograph album has been shared with family and friends, perhaps you would like to relive the moment and let those closest to you witness the restating of your vows to each other and follow with a celebratory party at the venue of your choice. Warwickshire Registration Service will be happy to assist you in making your arrangements and conducting just such a ceremony.

Renewal ceremonies can take place at any of the registration offices in Warwickshire or at any of our approved venues.

The renewal ceremony has no legal standing: this allows the freedom for each couple to create a unique celebration to suit their own particular requirements. A typical renewal of vows ceremony will contain:

- An introduction and welcome.
- The acknowledgement of any children of the marriage.
- Readings by friends or the couple themselves.
- Re-dedication of rings, or giving of new rings or gifts.
- The signing of the commemorative certificate.
- Closing words.

You will receive an options booklet to assist you with your planning. All choices not in our booklet must be approved by registration staff.





# NAMING CEREMONIES

#### A NAMING CEREMONY IS A WONDERFUL OPPORTUNITY TO CELEBRATE THE BIRTH OF A BABY OR WELCOME ADOPTED OR STEPCHILDREN INTO YOUR WIDER FAMILY CIRCLE.

This secular ceremony is designed as an alternative to a religious celebration and has no legal standing, but it creates a special event at which to gather together family and friends for a dignified but relaxed occasion.

#### A naming ceremony:

- welcomes a new child or children into your family and enables you to express love, care and commitment to them in front of your family and friends.
- celebrates the name of a new child or children.
- enables supporting adults or grandparents to publicly promise to help and support your child or children as they grow up within our community.

Our ceremony is designed to meet the individual needs of your family and you may choose to personalise it further by including a reading of verse or a suitable piece of prose. Every ceremony is different and your own choice of content will ensure that it is a truly unique celebration that you and your family will remember as your child grows older.

You will receive an options booklet to assist you with your planning. All choices not in our booklet must be approved by registration staff.





ONCE AN APPLICATION TO BECOME A BRITISH CITIZEN HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE HOME OFFICE, EACH NEW CITIZEN (AGED OVER 18) IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND A CEREMONY IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE CITIZENSHIP STATUS.

The final part of the process of becoming a British citizen is to attend one of these special ceremonies. Group ceremonies take place regularly at Shire Hall, Warwick in the presence of a civic dignitary or alternatively, individuals can opt for a private ceremony at any of our registration offices (an additional fee is charged for this).

The ceremony formally welcomes new arrivals into the British family. It confers rights and acknowledges responsibilities. By definition, nationality means to have membership of a particular nation - in this case, the nation is the United Kingdom.

At a citizenship ceremony, new citizens are required to make promises and swear or affim an oath to the sovereign that they will be faithful citizens. They must also make a formal and public pledge to be loyal subjects and observe the laws of this country.

The ceremony concludes when new citizens are presented with their certificate of naturalisation.





# EQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### HOW MUCH WILL OUR **CEREMONY COST** AND WHEN DO WE HAVE TO PAY?

The price of a ceremony is dependent on the day and location that you have chosen. Please contact one of the Warwickshire Register Offices who will be happy to provide you with details or visit our website - www.warwickshire.gov.uk/ registrations.

Reservations / non-refundable booking fees will be taken at early stages of booking your ceremony with the remaining balance becoming due twelve weeks before the ceremony date.

#### CAN ONE OF US BE 'FASHIONABLY LATE'?

Unfortunately not. You must be ready to start your ceremony on time - we are unable to delay the start of your celebration as we will most likely be conducting another ceremony after yours and we will not risk being late for another couple's booking. If you are late for your ceremony, you risk us not being able to proceed as planned which would be extremely upsetting, so please make sure that you allow enough time to get ready and arrive at the venue calmly and promptly!

#### I DON'T WANT TO BE SEEN BY MY PARTNER/GUESTS PRIOR TO THE CEREMONY -IS THAT POSSIBLE?

We conduct separate interviews at all of our venues and their staff are wellpracticed in keeping you hidden until the last moment. We will also endeavor to assist with this at our registration offices.

#### WHAT HAPPENS IF I FORGET WHAT I HAVE TO SAY IN THE CEREMONY?

You do not need to learn and remember the words you need to say at the ceremony. The registrar will ask you to repeat all vows after them and will break them down into bite-size chunks.





#### I AM WORRIED THAT I MAY MAKE A MISTAKE IN MY VOWS OR START TO LAUGH OR CRY?

We understand that these types of ceremonies are significant events in your life, that emotions run very high and you may be extremely nervous. If you make a mistake, the registrar will repeat what you need to say or help you correct the words. Please don't be embarrassed - all of your guests are there to celebrate your special occasion with you and will not mind if you show some nerves or make a mistake. If you have a giggle or shed a tear, most of them will probably join you!

#### CAN WE WRITE OUR OWN VOWS?

You must say the legal vows at your ceremony but you can choose to add some extra words, if you wish. You will need to have these approved by the Superintendent Registrar prior to the ceremony, so please return them with your checklist in plenty of time.

#### CAN A FRIEND/FAMILY MEMBER WRITE A READING FOR OUR CEREMONY?

Yes, if you are having your ceremony at an approved premises, although the registration staff must approve it prior to the ceremony, so please include it with your checklist. If they are writing it as a surprise for you, they can send it to us under separate cover, but it cannot be read at the ceremony unless it has been approved.

#### IS THERE ANYTHING I NEED TO AVOID WHEN WRITING MY OWN VOWS OR CHOOSING MUSIC AND **READINGS?**

You are not allowed any religious content in your ceremony, so we are unable to accept hymns or religious music such as some choral works/arias. Similarly, you are not able to have readings from the Bible or any verse or prose that has religious connotation. All readings must be approved prior to your ceremony, so we will be happy to discuss any gueries you have early in your planning.

#### CAN MEMBERS OF OUR FAMILY BE WITNESSES AT OUR MARRIAGE/CIVIL PARTNERSHIP?

Your witnesses can be members of your family or you may choose friends. They must be able to speak English (as they must have understood the vows you exchange) and understand the nature and purpose of marriage or civil partnership.

#### IS THERE ANY PARTICULAR WAY I HAVE TO SIGN THE REGISTER OR SCHEDULE?

You will be asked to sign your usual signature on the register or schedule in the same way that you would sign an application form or cheque.





#### WHAT IF WE NEED TO CANCEL OUR CEREMONY -WILL WE GET ANY MONEY BACK?

The registration service has a detailed cancellation policy which will determine whether you are entitled to a refund - this depends on how much you have paid and how far ahead of the ceremony date you have cancelled. If you do need to cancel your ceremony, please contact us as soon as possible and we will advise you of your individual situation. The full cancellation policy can be found on our website and is included in the ceremony pack that you will receive at the time of booking.

#### CAN WE HAVE A **CEREMONY OUTSIDE?**

We now license garden structures at some of our venues, which enable a ceremony to take place outside between March and October. Please contact us for further information on which venues have this option and the terms and conditions surrounding such bookings.

#### CAN WE HAVE A CEREMONY IN OUR BACK GARDEN?

Currently, the law requires that a marriage and civil partnership ceremony must be held at a licensed venue and so this prevents the option to have a ceremony in your house (excluding those that qualify under the housebound section of the Marriage Act). Warwickshire conducts naming or renewal of vows ceremonies at those venues that hold a marriage and civil partnership licence.

#### WE ARE HAVING A BLESSING IN A CHURCH/ **OVERSEAS AFTER THE** LEGAL CEREMONY, CAN WE SIMPLIFY THE CIVIL CEREMONY?

We understand that you may be having another celebration and are happy to accommodate your wishes for a simplified ceremony. You must exchange vows and sign the register or schedule in front of your witnesses, but may choose to leave the exchange of rings and readings until your blessing. Please just indicate this on your checklist and we will tailor our ceremony accordingly.





#### CAN I CHANGE MY NAME ON MY PASSPORT BEFORE MY CEREMONY?

You can apply to change your name on your passport up to three months prior to your ceremony date by applying to the IPS and completing a PD2 form to accompany your application. Please ensure that the name on any of your flight/travel bookings and the name on your passport is going to be the same if you are going overseas after your ceremony – if they are different, you may be refused boarding onto aircraft or entry into another country.

#### CAN WE WRITE OUR OWN CEREMONY?

No, we will do this. The registrar performing your ceremony will provide the script for your ceremony which will not only include the legal vows, but also additional words that you can say to each other, for example at the exchange of rings. The ceremony will contain more detail than the framework printed in your ceremony pack (as this is just an

outline) and will ensure that you have an enjoyable celebration as well as fulfilling all the legal obligations. If you are holding your ceremony at an approved premises and would like to write additional personal vows to exchange, we would be more than happy to include them, provided they have been approved by the Superintendent Registrar before your ceremony and that they do not contain any religious content, but there is no requirement for you to provide the whole ceremony as that is part of the service we provide.

#### CAN OUR GUESTS SING A SONG AS PART OF THE CEREMONY?

You can include a song instead of a reading if you wish for either your guests to sing as a group or for one guest to sing for you. However, as with all content, it cannot contain any religious connotation (for example, you are not able to have a hymn) and must be approved by the Superintendent Registrar prior to the ceremony.




