

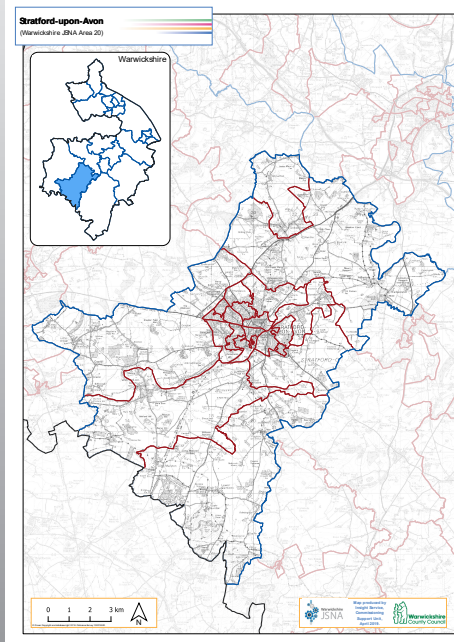

of homes are privately rented. Higher than district (13%) and county (14%) levels



Atrial Fibrillation rates have increased in recent years and in 2017/18 were significantly higher than the England rate at four practices in the JSNA area



Significantly higher rates of Hypertension were recorded at four GP practices in 2017/18 when compared to the England average

Osteoporosis prevalence in those over 50 years was significantly higher than national levels at four GP practices



Crude emergency admission rates for Coronary Heart Disease were noticeably higher in 6 LSOAS in the JSNA area compared to the county 4 year average

The four year crude rate for emergency admissions relating to self harm in 10-24 year olds was higher (5.4 per 1,000) in the JSNA area than county levels (4.2 per 1,000)



A lower proportion of children in Reception (18.6%) and Year 6 (24%) were 'overweight' or 'very overweight' compared to Warwickshire (24%/30%).

**4,000**

residents were recorded as providing some unpaid care each week. Of these, over 700 provide care for 50+ hours per week



The JSNA area had the 4th highest number of referrals for alcohol issues than any other JSNA area in 2018/19

Young people (under 25) were recorded as providing some form of unpaid care each week. 103 were Under 18 and 35 were 8-11 years





**70.6%**

of children at KS2 (end of primary) achieved the expected level in reading, writing and maths, an improvement on 2017 (66.4%) and 2016 (65.1%).



**55.1%**

of students at KS4 achieved a 9-5 strong pass in English and Maths, higher than the county average (47.2%)

**27.0%**

of students in the LSOA of Maybird achieved the new Key Stage 4 measure of 9-5 (strong pass) in English and Maths, lower than the JSNA average of 55.1%

adult social care packages were for 'older people' or 'physical support' - in line with the county picture

children with disabilities were recorded by WCC in 2018 - a rate of 70 per 10,000 children, higher than both district (59.1) and county (56.0)
