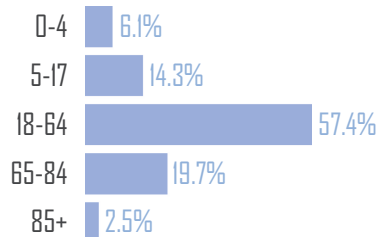


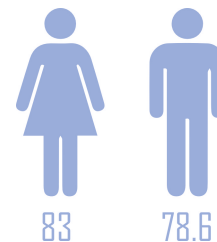

**Obesity**
