There has been a steady receipt of s130 notices which are being dealt with.

Maintenance work

The weather has caused significant issues in allowing any practical works to be undertaken. Work has been planned but had to be postponed because ground conditions prevent access.

Volunteer work

Since the last meeting 378 volunteer hours have been done. The work of volunteers has also been affected by the non stop heavy rain. The work they have undertaken has had to be adapted to take the conditions into account. This has been a mixture of tree clearance, fixing bridges damaged by flooding, installing way marker posts where ground conditions have allowed holes to be dug and general vegetation clearance. Preparatory work for bigger projects has also been undertaken – these projects to be completed when conditions improve.

Planning Applications

Since the last meeting 104 planning applications have been received and 111 responses sent (including those received before the meeting). There has been a lot of work undertaken with developers and the planning authorities to get good outcomes from development.

Legal Work

Work continues with DMMOs and PPOs but they have joined a backlog of work waiting attention with legal for order sealing and related work.

Volunteers

As a result of the public survey there have been a number of people who have expressed an interest in volunteering. This interest has been followed up by the Volunteer Coordinators. It is a much appreciated positive response.
