

Solihull MBC L.A.F. Meeting Report Period 4 - Jan/Feb/Mar 2025




Background:

The Service looks after all aspects of the management of the Public Rights of Way network in the borough which consists of approximately 250km of routes. All rights of way are Public Highway and afforded the same legislative and statutory protection as the wider network.

The service is responsible for Rights of Way: Maintenance, Asset Management, Promotion, Enforcement and Legal challenges

Maintenance work

- Ad-hoc maintenance of the PROWs continues on a reactive basis, continued requests for new/repairs to furniture, i.e. missing fingerposts and stiles/gates.
 We have a new ad-hoc vegetation maintenance contractor who's initial work has been very thorough.
- Summer strimming completed 3 week programme, strimming 131 sections of paths ~ 42,000 linear metres (from a total of 450 routes)
