**PLANNING AND COMPULSORY PURCHASE ACT 2004
(WARWICKSHIRE MINERAL AND WASTE DEVELOPMENT SCHEME (MWDS)
(NOVEMBER 2007)**

I am directed by the Secretary of State to refer to the submission of your Local Development Scheme on 29th March 2007 and to subsequent correspondence with your authority in relation to your Council's intention to bring the above version of the document into effect.

In accordance with Regulation 11(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, the Secretary of State hereby notifies your Council that she does not intend to issue a direction under Section 15(4) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

The holding direction issued to your authority on April 18th 2007 under Regulation 11(3)(c) of the Act is hereby withdrawn.

I would be grateful if you would advise me of the date the revised Local Development Scheme is brought into effect by your authority. At this time, to comply with Regulation 12(1)(a)(b) may I remind you of the need to make a copy of the Local Development Scheme available for public inspection at your principal office and to publish the scheme on your website.
