THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF NUNEATON & BEDWORTH) (RESTRICTED ROADS) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2020
B4114 LUTTERWORTH ROAD, NUNEATON

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to revoke and reimpose restricted road status (30 mph speed limit) on that length of the B4114 Lutterworth Road, Nuneaton which is described in the Schedule below. The Order commences on Monday 2 November 2020.

Any enquiries relating to the Order may be made to Ben Davenport, Communities Directorate, Warwickshire County Council (tel. no. 01926 410410). Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

B4114 Lutterworth Road, Nuneaton

From a point 50 metres east of the railway bridge, south-eastwards to a point 146 metres east of its junction with Thornhill Drive, a total distance of 1732 metres.
