**Background**

Following requests for enforcement of speed limits along the B4114 Lutterworth Road, inconsistencies between the names of the roads in the 30mph Traffic Regulation Order and the road names on the National Street Gazetteer have come to light. This has resulted in the proposals as indicated below.

**Statement of Reasons**

**B4114 Lutterworth Road – 30mph speed limit**

In order to fix a long-standing administrative error, it is necessary to redefine the length of the B4114 Lutterworth Road and classify it as a restricted road. This will aid in enforcement and will aid in avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

**Schedule**

In the schedule to the Principle Order, delete items 2 and 3 and insert the following;

**B4114 Lutterworth Road**

From a point 50 metres east of the railway bridge, south-eastwards to a point 146 metres east of its junction with Thornhill Drive, a total distance of 1732 metres.
