THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WELSH ROAD EAST, SOUTHAM)
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to introduce a 40 mph speed limit upon that length of Welsh Road East, Southam which is described in the Schedule below.
