STATEMENT OF REASONS

As part of Councillor Crump's delegated budget scheme it is proposed to introduce a 40 mph speed limit on that part of Welsh Road East, Southam which is described in the Schedule below, as a buffer zone into the existing 30 mph speed limit. The proposed 40 mph speed limit will encompass a new housing estate that has been built on the edge of Southam. The aim is to reduce vehicle speeds through this section of Welsh Road East as it is currently a national speed limit (60mph). A reduced speed limit would improve road safety and improve the environment for all road users. The scheme will involve the use of speed limit signage and associated road markings to reinforce the new limit.
