SCHEDULE 1

PROPOSED BUILD-OUT - WELFORD ROAD, LONG MARSTON

- (i) Welford Road (north) – From a point in line with the northern elevation of the property known as Staddle Stones, north for a distance of 14.5m.

Max 100mm high, 0.45m wide x 1.8m long.

PROPOSED BUILD-OUTS - LONG MARSTON ROAD, LONG MARSTON

- (ii) Long Marston Road (south) – From a point in line with the northern elevation of the property known as No2 The Brickall, south for a distance of 90.5m.

Max 100mm high, 0.45m wide x 1.8m long.
