WELFORD RD & LONG MARSTON RD, LONG MARSTON.

PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING.

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

A request has been received by Warwickshire County Council from Long Marston Parish Council for two Build-outs on the road through that village.

These improvements have been requested by residents through their elected representatives, including support from the County Councillor and the Highways Section have agreed this request is reasonable.

The two Build-outs will be located to the north and the south of the village. Its intention is to slow down the through traffic along Welford Road and Long Marston Road. The Build-out location and size is listed in Item 3. below.

The overall traffic calming effect is to increase safety for local residents and pedestrians and reduce the number of casualties in the immediate locale, currently standing at two over the last three years.

3. PROPOSED BUILD-OUT'S

3.1 Size of each Build-out to be Max 100mm high, 0.45m wide x 1.8m long.
(2No required)

3.2 Location to the centre of each Build-out is;

- (i) Welford Road (north) – From a point in line with the northern elevation of the property known as Staddle Stones, north for a distance of 14.5m.
- (ii) Long Marston Road (south) - From a point in line with the northern elevation of the property known as No2 The Brickall, south for a distance of 90.5m.
