PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING.

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

A request has been received by Warwickshire County Council from one of its elected representatives proposing to make improvements to the above named junction.

These improvements have been requested by residents through their local County Councillor and the Highways Section have agreed this request is reasonable.

The Build-outs to be added to the existing junction are designed to reduce the time a pedestrian is required to cross this wide bellmouth junction. The new radius should also slow down the turning traffic into George St. Details of each Build-out to the location is listed in Item 4. below.

The overall traffic calming effect is to increase safety for local residents and pedestrians and reduce the number of casualties in the immediate locale, currently standing at two over the last three years.
