ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WARWICK ROAD, KINETON)
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 40 mph speed limit on the length of road described in Schedule 1 below.

The Order commences on Friday 5th February 2021.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

(Reduction in speed limit from NSL (60 mph) to 40 mph)

1. Warwick Road, Kineton

from a point 253 metres north-west of its junction with Castle Road north-westwards for 489 metres.
