ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, LIGHTHORNE, KINETON AND GAYDON)
(30 & 50 MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2014

The Warwickshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under section 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on those lengths of road as described in Schedule 1 to this Order.
2. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on those lengths of road as described in Schedule 2 to this Order.
3. The provisions of Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to a vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of The Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when such a vehicle is used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. The Warwickshire County Council (Church Lane and Moreton Morrell Lane, Lighthorne) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2009 is hereby revoked.
5. This Order may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Various Roads, Lighthorne, Kineton and Gaydon) (30 & 50 mph Speed Limits) Order 2014" and shall come into operation on the Second day of June Two thousand and fourteen.

SCHEDULE 1
(30 mph Speed Limits)

1. **Church Lane, Lighthorne**

From its junction with Moreton Morrell Lane, westwards then northwards for a distance of 156 metres.

2. **Moreton Morrell Lane, Lighthorne**

From its junction with Church Lane, south-westwards for a distance of 127 metres.

SCHEDULE 2
(50 mph Speed Limits)

1. Bishops Hill (Lighthorne)

From a point 65 metres south of its junction with Verney Close, southwards to its junction with Bishops Gorse Road (being a distance of approximately 950 metres).

2. Chesterton Road (Lighthorne - B4100 Banbury Road)

From a point 240 metres north of its junction with Church Lane, northwards to its junction with the B4100 Banbury Road (a distance of approximately 890 metres).

3. Heath Farm Lane / Bishops Gorse Road / Lighthorne Rough Road (Lighthorne - B4455 Fosse Way)

From a point in Heath Farm Lane 10 metres south of its junction with Old School Lane, south-eastwards then westwards to a point in Lighthorne Rough Road 15 metres east of its junction with the B4455 Fosse Way (being a distance of approximately 4.3 kilometres).

4. Lighthorne Road (Lighthorne Rough Road - Lighthorne Road)

From its eastern junction with Lighthorne Rough Road, south-westwards for a distance of 940 metres.

5. Lighthorne Road (Kineton - B4455 Fosse Way)

From its western junction with Lighthorne Rough Road, south-eastwards to a point 198 metres north of its junction with Palmers Leys (being a distance of approximately 3.8 kilometres).

6. Moreton Morrell Lane (Lighthorne - B4455 Fosse Way)

From a point 127 metres south-west of its junction with Church Lane, westwards to its junction with the B4455 Fosse Way (being a distance of approximately 1.6 kilometres).

7. Southam Road (Kineton - Gaydon)

From a point 170 metres north-east of its junction with Glosters Green, north-eastwards to a point 120 metres south-west of its junction with St Marks Close (being a distance of approximately 3.5 kilometres).

8. Watery Lane (Chadshunt)

From its junction with Southam Road, south-eastwards for its entire length (being a distance of approximately 1.85 kilometres).
