**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF NUNEATON AND
BEDWORTH) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON-STREET
PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION 3)
ORDER 2021**

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough of Nuneaton and Bedworth) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) Consolidation Order 2017, as briefly described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedule below.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in the Schedule below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.
