ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Warwickshire County Council (Gallows Hill, Heathcote) (No Waiting at any Time) Order 2021.

1. BACKGROUND

1.1 Request to extend Double Yellow Lines north and south of the existing Double Yellow Lines on Gallows Hill, on the unnamed road (north) and unnamed road (south) on the approaches to a new crossroad northwest of the roundabout junction with the A452.

2. STATEMENT OF REASONS

2.1 Gallows Hill, Heathcote, Warwick.

Housing development of land adjacent to Gallows Hill on the southeastern side of Warwick, has led to a proposal to implement a signalised crossroads for the access roads. Double Yellow Lines are proposed on these access roads to prevent waiting and allow the free flow of traffic.

3. SCHEDULE 1

3.1. Plan Ref. TR11341 / 99 to be included in Schedule 1 and attached to the Order.

3.2. Unnamed Road (north) off Gallows Hill - No Waiting At Any Time

(i) From a point on the northern side of the junction with unnamed road (north) in line with the back of the footway on Gallows Hill, in a generally northern direction for 84.0m.

3.3. Unnamed Road (south) off Gallows Hill - No Waiting At Any Time

(i) From a point on the southern side of the junction with unnamed road (south) in line with the back of the footway on Gallows Hill, in a generally southern direction for 56.5m.

3.4 Gallows Hill – No Stopping At Any Time Except Authorised Vehicles

(i) An area on the south side of Gallows Hill, 25.0m west of the junction with Unnamed Road (south) for a distance of 16.0m in a northwesterly direction.
