PROPOSED INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES

RAISED SPEED HUMP/PEDESTRIAN REFUGE & BUILD OUT

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 1.1 Warwickshire County Council is proposing to introduce a raised speed hump with associated pedestrian refuge and a build out on Clemens Street, Leamington Spa.
- 1.2 The scheme involves the installation of a new raised speed hump in association with a pedestrian refuge to allow Pedestrians to cross, and a build out for pedestrians to improve Pedestrian movements in crossing Clemens Street, Leamington Spa. The scheme is proposed to enhance the existing four raised speed humps on Clemens Street, which are to be changed from block paving to tarmac surfacing, with a coloured surfacing on a number of them ,to improve the environment for businesses, residents, and especially pedestrians and cyclists by further restricting vehicle speeds and improving road safety.
- 1.3 The location of the speed tables/cushions is as set out in schedule 1 and can be referred to in drawings **TR11264-02, TR11264-03**

2. SCHEDULE

SCHEDULE 1

(Location of speed humps/pedestrian refuge and build out.)

1. Clemens Street outside property numbers 25a & 25b & opposite property no`s 32a & 32b - Build Out

The existing parking bay will be replaced by a build out 1.8 m wide,8.8m long and 75mm high outside property no`s 25a & 25b & opposite property no`s 32a & 32b Clemens Street.

2. Clemens Street outside property numbers 66 to 70 & 43 & 41 proposed raised speed humps with associated pedestrian refuge.

Raised Pedestrian speed hump 5.5 wide,0.75m high and 6.4m wide, Pedestrian refuge to be 2m wide,8m long located in the centre of the carriageway and speed hump outside property no`s 66 to 70 & 43 & 41 Clemens Street.
