THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF NUNEATON AND BEDWORTH) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON-STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION 3) ORDER 2021

Warwickshire County Council have made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough of Nuneaton and Bedworth) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) Consolidation Order 2017, as briefly described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedule below. The Order commences on 21 June 2021.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in the Schedule below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of the Order to be varied, plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, are available on the Council's website at https://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/news/20207/nuneaton-bedworth-borough and may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick during usual opening hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

High Street, Nuneaton – Disabled Badge Holders Only

East side, from a point 150 metres north of its junction with Pool Bank Street, Northwards for 6.6 metres.
