HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 90A & 90G

**PROPOSED EXTENSION TO
EXISTING RAISED TABLE FEATURE AND INTRODUCTION OF A DROPPED
CROSSING ON WELSH ROAD WEST, SOUTHAM, STRATFORD**

Warwickshire County Council proposes, under section 90A & 90G of the Highways Act 1980, to extend the existing raised table feature and introduce a dropped crossing on Welsh Road West, Southam, as described in more detail in the Schedule below.
