THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A435 GORCOTT HILL, STRATFORD DISTRICT) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 50 mph speed limit on the length of road mentioned in the Schedule below. The Order commences on 5 July 2021.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

A435 Gorcott Hill - Existing NSL70 to become 50mph

- (i) From the existing 40mph / National Speed Limit terminal point on the A435 south of the A4023, in a north easterly direction along the A435 northbound carriageway of Gorcott Hill for a distance of 450m
- (ii) From the existing 40mph / National Speed Limit terminal point on the A435 south of the A4023, in a north easterly direction along the A435 southbound carriageway of Gorcott Hill for a distance of 450m.
