Mallory Road, Bishops Tachbrook

From its junction with Holt Avenue, westwards for a distance of 172 metres.

SCHEDULE 2 (Proposed 40 mph Speed Limit)

Mallory Road, Bishops Tachbrook

From its junction with Banbury Road, eastwards to a point 172 metres west of its junction with Holt Avenue.
