ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WELSH ROAD EAST, SOUTHAM)
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to introduce a 40 mph speed limit upon that length of Welsh Road East, Southam which is described in the Schedule below. The Order commences on Monday 9 August 2021.

Any enquiries relating to the Order may be made to Chris Round, Communities Directorate, Warwickshire County Council (tel. no. 01926 413789). Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

Welsh Road East, Southam

From a point 157 metres south-east of its junction with Hodnell Drive, in a south-easterly direction along Welsh Road East for a distance of 600 metres.
