THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (POTFORD BRIDGE, LINDEN LANE, POLESWORTH) (7.5 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2021

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to impose a 7.5 tonne maximum gross weight restriction on that length of Linden Lane, Polesworth, which is carried by the bridge known as Potford Bridge over Bramcote Brook. The Order commences on Monday 18 October 2021.
