## THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHURCH HILL/HIGH STREET, COLESHILL) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN) ORDER, 1998

The Warwickshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause any vehicle proceeding in Church Hill, Coleshill to make a right turn into High Street.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation on the 24 November 1696 and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Church Hill/High Street, Coleshill) (Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 1998".
