

## **PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER**

**Birmingham Road ,Ansley, North Warwickshire**

**PROPOSED 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT EXTENSION**

### **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

In accordance with the Department of Transport Circular 01/2013 Setting Local Speed Limits, an extension of the existing 30mph speed limit is being introduced on the Birmingham Road, Ansley. This is for vehicles on the Northern entrance to Ansley Village travelling south westerly before they approach the new traffic calming chicane which will be located outside House No 1a Birmingham Road, which is described in the Schedule below. The aim is to reduce vehicle speeds on their approach to Ansley Village from the north, so that they are travelling at a safe speed when they approach the new chicane located outside House No 1a Birmingham Road. A reduced speed limit would improve road safety and improve the environment for all road users. The scheme will involve the use of speed limit signage and associated road markings to reinforce the new limit.
