

BIRMINGHAM ROAD, ANSLEY NORTH WARWICKSHIRE

Proposed Chicanes

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 1.1 A request has been received by Warwickshire County Council from Birmingham Road ,Ansley Action Group and supported by Councillor Margaret Bell the Local County Councillor for Ansley for three Chicanes on the road through Ansley village.
- 1.2 These improvements have been requested by residents through the elected representatives, including support from the County Councillor and the Highways Section who have agreed this request is reasonable.
- 1.3 The proposed chicanes to be installed will measure approximately 5.0 – 6.95 metres (length) x 1.6 – 1.9 metres (Width) x 100mm (height) in three locations on Birmingham Road, Ansley, North Warwickshire, as detailed in Schedule 1.
- 1.2 The scheme will also involve the use of warning signs, bollards, road markings as well as chicanes. The chicanes will help improve the environment for residents, pedestrians, and cyclists by restricting vehicle speeds and improving road safety.
- 1.3 The location of the chicanes is set out in schedule 1 and can be referred to in drawing no`s TR11120-05 – TR11120-07.

2. SCHEDULE

SCHEDULE 1 (Location of speed chicanes)

1. Proposed priority give-way chicane Birmingham Road just North of House No 1A, Build Out 6m long x 100mm high x 1.6m wide, running carriageway width of 4.5m, total road width 6.1m.
2. Proposed priority give-way chicane Birmingham Road outside Village Hall, Build Out 5m long x 100mm high x 1.6m wide, running carriageway width 4.5m, total road width 6.1m.
3. Proposed priority give-way chicane Birmingham Road outside Lord Nelson Inn, Build Out 6.95m long x 100mm high x 1.9m wide, running carriageway width 4.5m, total road width 6.4m.
