#### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 90G AND ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

#### BIRMINGHAM ROAD, ANSLEY NORTH WARWICKSHIRE PROPOSED CHICANES (TRAFFIC CALMING FEATURES) AND THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BIRMINGHAM ROAD, ANSLEY) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

Warwickshire County Council propose, under section 90G of the Highways Act 1980, to install 3 priority give-way chicanes on Birmingham Road, Ansley, as described in more detail in Schedule 1 below and to make the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 30 mph speed limit on the length of road mentioned in Schedule 2 below.

- 1. Proposed priority give-way chicane Birmingham Road just North of House No 1A,Build Out 6m long x 100mm high x 1.6m wide, running carriageway width of 4.5m,total road width 6.1m.
- 2. Proposed priority give-way chicane Birmingham Road outside Village Hall, Build Out 5m long x 100mm high x 1.6m wide, running carriageway width 4.5m,total road width 6.1m.
- 3. Proposed priority give-way chicane Birmingham Road outside Lord Nelson Inn,Build Out 6.95m long x 100mm high x 1.9m wide, running carriageway width 4.5m,total road width 6.4m.

## SCHEDULE 2

#### Birmingham Road, Ansley

From a point 136.9 meters in a south-easterly direction from the centre line of Ansley Lane, for 100metres in a North-westerly direction towards Ansley Lane.
