ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(A429 WELLESBOURNE BYPASS & VARIOUS ROADS, WELLESBOURNE)
(40 MPH & 50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017

The Warwickshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road described in the Schedule 1 to this Order.
2. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of road described in the Schedule 2 to this Order.
3. The provisions of Articles 1 and 2 of this Order shall not apply to a vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of The Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when such a vehicle is used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. This Order may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (A429 Wellesbourne Bypass & various Roads, Wellesbourne) (40 mph & 50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2017" and shall come into operation on the 8th day of June Two Thousand and Seventeen.

SCHEDULE 1

(40mph Speed Limit)

1. A429 Wellesbourne Bypass and A429 Red Hill

From a point 75 metres north of its junction (centre of junction) with Ettington Road to a point 135 metres south of its junction (centre of roundabout) with the un-named estate roads (westside and eastside) to the new housing developments.

2. Ettington Road

From its junction (centre of junction) with A429 Wellesbourne Bypass in an easterly then northerly direction for 45 metres.

3. Lowes Lane

From its junction (centre of junction) with Ettington Road in a south-easterly direction for 20 metres.

4. Joseph Arch Road

From its junction (centre of roundabout) with A429 Wellesbourne Bypass and A429 Red Hill eastwards for 40 metres.

5. Un-named estate road (Eastside)

From its junction (centre of roundabout) with A429 Red Hill eastwards for 45 metres.

6. Un-named estate road (Westside)

From its junction (centre of roundabout) with A429 Red Hill westwards for 45 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

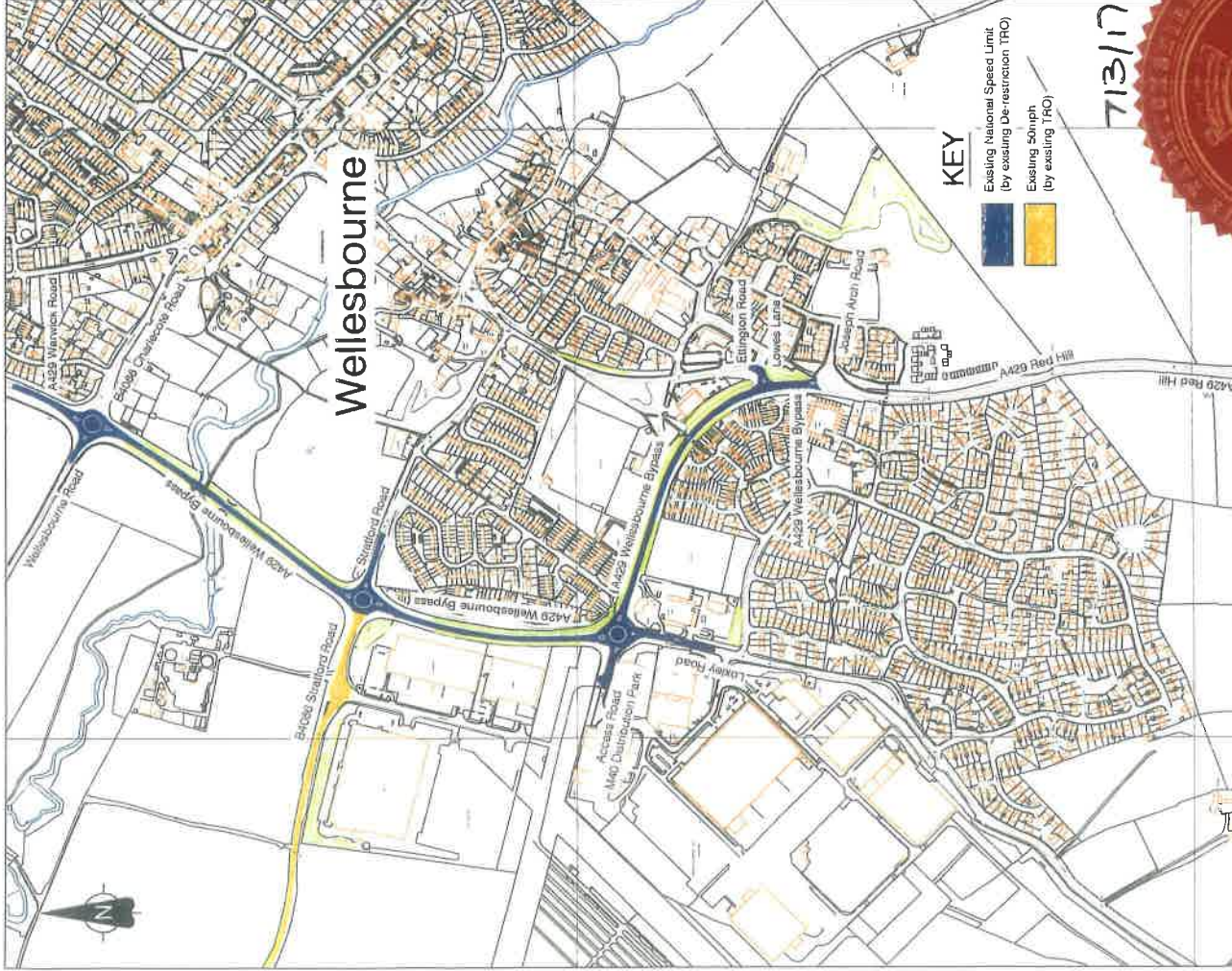
(50mph Speed Limit)

1. A429 Wellesbourne Bypass

From a point 40 metres south of its junction (centre of roundabout) with B4086 Stratford Road in a southerly, then south-easterly, then southerly direction to a point 75 metres north of its junction (centre of junction) with Ettington Road

2. M40 Distribution Park Access Road

For its entire length.

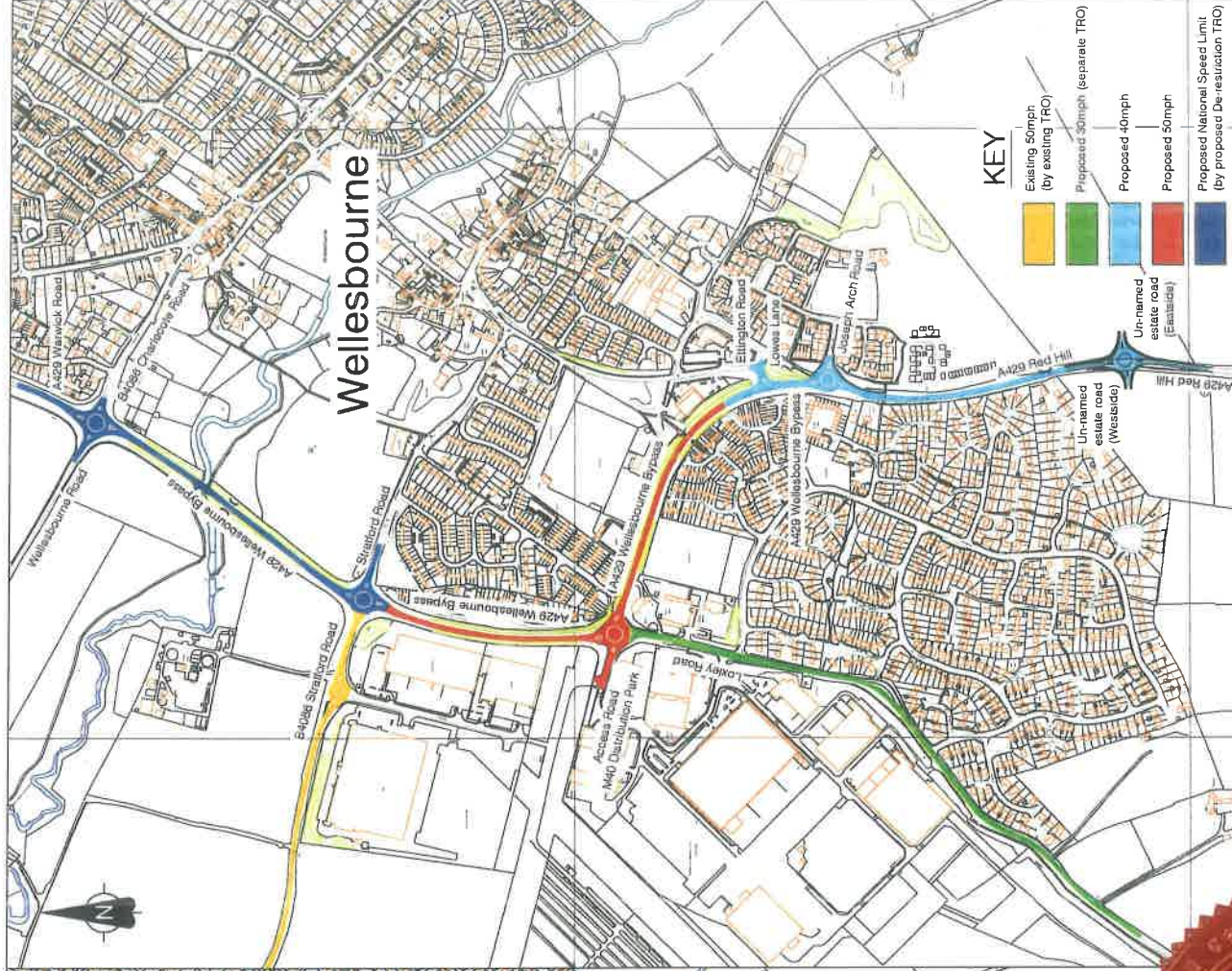


Wellesbourne
