**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF NUNEATON & BEDWORTH)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON-STREET PARKING PLACES & RESIDENTS' PARKING)
(CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION E) ORDER 2022**

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough of Nuneaton & Bedworth) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places & Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017 (as varied) to introduce the following:-

- (i) a virtual permit system for all types of parking permit;
- (ii) an application process for parking dispensations for vehicles being used to carry out essential works, at cost of £15 per day;
- (iii) an application process for parking bay suspensions at a cost of £60.
