**(Proposed 30 mph Speed Limits)**

**Bishopton Lane, Stratford upon Avon**

From its junction with the roundabout at Timothy's Bridge Road, in a generally south-westerly direction to its junction with The Ridgeway.

**The Ridgeway, Stratford upon Avon**

From its junctions with the A422 Alcester Road, in a generally north-westerly direction for a distance of 551 metres.
